
## 4 Maintain Your Trust in Allah 🦫

▶ The **liberation of Palestine is promised** to us as Muslims. The Prophet said to a Sahabi, Ibn Hawwalah, "Oh Ibn Hawwalah, if you see that the Caliphate has taken abode in the Holy Land (Palestine) then the earthquakes and tribulations and great events are at hand. The last Hour on that day will be closer to people than my hand is to your head". [Ahmad, Abu Dawud]

Many believe that the liberation of Palestine is distant, impossible, or far-fetched – but our Ummah has experienced this struggle in the past. Al-Aqsa was occupied by the Crusadersfor 88 years before Salahuddin came about and united the Ummah and liberated it. Today, al-Aqsa has been occupied for over 75 years. We need, from within our ummah, more people who have the vision and steadfastness of Salahuddin, who aim to unite the ummah, and to liberate al-Aqsa and all other occupied lands.

So what can every one of us do?

## 1 Set 'liberation' as your target

When we fail to set ourselves specific goals, it is easy to be lost with our activism or even be swayed in different directions. To remain on the right track, we should make our goals clear, individually and as a community and ummah – that our goal is to liberate Palestine completely from occupation, from the river to the sea, and to provide the justice of Islam to the blessed land. This goal should be stated loudly, proudly, and passed on between our generations.

## 2 Make Dua

Victory and liberation is in the hands of Allah , and He will grant victory at the time it is most befitting. Dua is the weapon of the believer, so we should continue to call upon Him with our dua on a regular basis, particularly at the times it is most accepted, and have firm faith that Allah will accept your dua.

## 3 Continue the political struggle

Some political actions that can be taken include:

- Decolonise your mind by learning about the history of the occupation and division of our lands, and learning more about Islam's political solutions for the issues in Palestine and elsewhere in the Muslim world.
- Challenge the ideas and concepts which have resulted in the demise of our ummah, such as secularism, nationalism, and liberalism, and provide Islam's political system as an alternative solution to revive and unite the Ummah, and therefore liberate Palestine.
- Create awareness around the issue and its link to our Aqeedah, ensuring it is framed correctly, as an exclusively Islamic issue, and not an Arab or Palestinian issue.
- Reignite the correct Islamic political concepts in the Ummah and the local Muslim community.
- Clearly provide the correct solutions for Palestine from an Islamic perspective, and work to counter any incorrect and problematic proposals such as the 'two-state solution'.
- Mobilise politically, together with and in support of the Muslims of Palestine, to resist any notion that seeks to relinquish a single inch of Palestine.
- Hold to account anyone who supports the Zionist occupation, including media outlets, Western rulers, and the tyrant regimes in the Muslim world who aid and normalise ties with the occupiers.
